This is a nice and very simple little piece of resin cast scenery. It is 5" along each external wall, and the internal wall length is a shade under 4" and it stands a respectable 2" high at the top of the parapet and there's 13/16" of cover behind the parapet - ample for a 28mm figures if it is to still see out and be able to fire (as shown in the photo)!



Its main use is probably to represent a field fortification rather than a proper bunker and as such as it is open topped with the walls forming only a moderately exposed firing platform. It could be used as the entrance to a larger bunker complex located "under the table" with the addition of a suitable access hatch.

One of these would make a good objective for a game - however another possibility would be to have a string of them across the table offering interlinking fire support. Or to have a

larger fortification for which these represent either outlying "machine gun nests" or possible "sally ports".

It's robust, and can be painted up very quickly - undercoat black, and then either concrete or a gunmetal type main coat. It would depend on how you see your SF - I'm sure that for GW's WH40K the nice solid metal is more appropriate although goodness knows how The Emperor pays for it! Whichever you pick it would then just require a bit of dry brushing to bring out the detail such as a panel and ladder, and a little shading for the small shell holes that pock-mark it. A nice touch is that Total System Scenic also sell a damaged version of this bunker.

For what seems a very reasonable price it hardly seems worth taking the time to scratch build one of your own - simple though such a building would obviously be.
