The book starts with a basic overview of the army and its structure. There is a short section on tactics, followed by a fairly long discussion of uniforms. The longest section focuses on the regiments of the Prussian army ó each is listed, with year of formation, leaders and actions that the regiment participated in.

The plates depict various regiments ó uniforms are similar, with facing colours and other minor items distinguishing them.

This book is for the uniform buff really and those interested in the organisation of the army; there is no history and only a very short section on tactics.
