Colour plates:

A range of infantry, almost all in campaign dress from Algeria, Tunisia, Sicily, Italy, Anzio and southern France

Comments:

The main focus is on organisation and unusual units like airborne troops, mountain troops, Japanese-Americans, African-Americans and Rangers. There are tables of organisation for heavy and light armoured divisions and airborne divisions 1942 & 1944. Crew-served weapons and soft-skin vehicles make up the bulk of the remainder. Campaign summary includes, Algeria, Tunisia, Sicily, Italy and South of France.
