In their hey-day, the *Tru-Craft* model soldiers were not considered as "toy soldiers" such as Britains, Mignots, Johilco and others. They were much more elaborate soldiers and were painted as such.

We feel fortunate to be able to re-issue this marvelous line of 54mm Model soldiers that have not been manufactured since 1960. Mrs. Darlene Trudell, who's father began the Tru-Craft Manufacturing Company in the early 40's has given us the OK to produce under license the famous *Tru-Craft* Military Miniatures.

Cecil Jackson had a dream of making his line of Tru-Craft soldiers the finest in the world. At the time he began, Britains and Mignot ruled the miniature world, and they were almost the only figures available. Jackson hired Carl Romanelli to design his originals and over the years they developed a line of Civil War soldiers, French Foreign Legionnaires, Football players and many other fine figures.

These figures were much superior to anything on the market at the time, but were priced much higher than Britains or Mignots and suffered accordingly. Actually, Jackson had developed a line of connoisseur-type figures for a market that was not ready for them, and in the end he was forced to close down because of lack of sales.

Mrs. Trudell has furnished us with the original pattern figures that Romanelli made and we are now marketing a limited number of these models under the *Tru-Craft* name.

In reproducing Cecil Jackson's Tru-Craft soldiers, we have tried to duplicate this fact, and you'll find our paint jobs are not the "toy soldier" type painting, but are painted on a little higher level as were the originals. They are finished in matte, not gloss, and are sold in boxes of six infantry models, including either an officer or drummer (or bugler) and five soldiers per set. They are packaged in a glossy red box under our "Old Time Toy Soldier" label. Painted single figures are not available.

Unpainted models are available in kit form and require some assembly, although this is mostly adding an arm, weapon, or knapsack as opposed to the standard kits produced by other manufacturers.

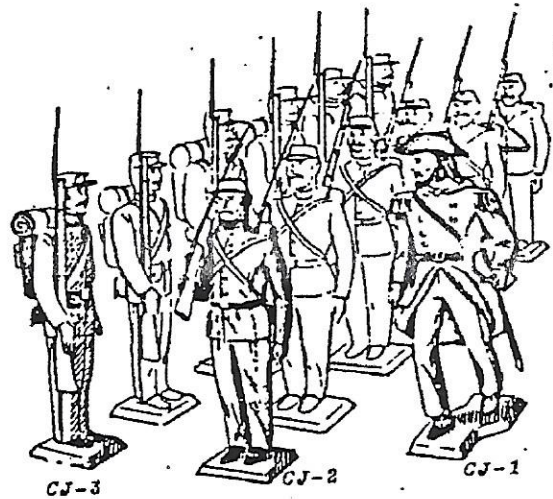

Paints and Brushes

Here is a list of paints- both bottled and spray cans- that we use to paint our Toy Soldiers and Wargame figures.

We normally use Polly S acrylic paints to paint "over" Testors- i.e paint a red coat , then paint over the red with Polly S white for belts, etc. If you use Testors white, the red will often "melt" in with the white because both are enamel based paints

We especially like the "flat" Testors enamels for painting large areas, such as coats and pants, while we prefer the "gloss" Testors for guns, hats, shoes, and other parts that are handled a lot while the figure is being painted.

Testors Enamel Paints

1/4 oz bottles. Must use thinner or mineral spirits to clean brushes. \$1 per bottle

In general, most Testors are gloss finish paint unless specifically call "flat" The gloss paint gives a "hard" finish and is recommended for hats, shoes, guns, etc where pieces are handled a lot while the figure is being painted. The flat Testors goes on much easier, but is a "softer" finish. Since model Toy Soldiers should be sprayed with a gloss finish anyhow, this doesn't make much difference
